

POST OPERATIVE SEDATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Patient <u>cannot drive for 24 hours</u> after taking sedation medication.
- 2. Patient cannot make any important decisions for 24 hours after taking sedation medication.
- 3. Do not operate any hazardous devices or do any heavy lifting for 24 hours.
- 4. A <u>responsible adult</u> should be with the patient until he/she has fully recovered from the effects of the sedation.
- 5. Patients should not go up and down stairs unattended. Let the patient stay on the ground floor until recovered.
- 6. Having nutrition after sedation is important. The patient should <u>begin eating soft foods as soon as possible.</u> Do not delay.
- 7. Patient needs to <u>drink plenty of fluids</u> as soon as possible and stay hydrated.
- 8. <u>No sedatives or stimulants should be taken for 24 hours</u> after the appointment (including alcohol, caffeine, cola, nicotine, or recreational drugs).
- 9. Patient may seem alert when he/she leaves. This may be misleading so do not leave the patient alone.
- 10. Always hold patient's arm when walking.
- 11. Patient should not be caring for infants or young children until the next day after the sedation appointment.
- 12. <u>Drive directly home & call the office when you arrive at home and the patient is comfortable and safe</u>. Office phone number is (619) 216-2121.
- 13. Please follow post operative instructions and take medication as prescribed by your dentist.
- 14. Do not hesitate to call our office if there are any questions or concerns.
- 15. If you feel that your symptoms warrant a physician and you are unable to reach us, go to the closest emergency room immediately.
